Belgian Prime Minister Van Rompuy addressed a crowd of 120 business leaders and officials at AmCham Belgium's Annual Dinner, held at Le Méridien Hotel in Brussels on Monday, June 15.

Following opening remarks by AmCham Belgium President Scott Beardsley, Van Rompuy emphasized the importance of US investment to growth, employment and new business concepts in Belgium. Even with the current crisis, the Prime Minister was adamant about Belgium's position as an attractive investment nation. Although Belgium and the US have reacted differently to the economic crisis, they both share the same goal: to ensure this crisis never occurs again. Obama announces nomination for Ambassador to Belgium

US President Obama has announced his intent to designate Howard W. Gutman as new Ambassador to Belgium.

Mr. Gutman is currently a partner at Williams & Connolly LLP and has been named one of "Washington's Top Lawyers" by Washingtonian Magazine. His background focuses on commercial litigation, including securities, partnership disputes. Previously, Mr. Gutman has served as a Special Assistant to F.B.I. Director William H. Webster, a position that focused on counter-terrorism and counter-intelligence.

The US Congress now needs to approve the nomination before Mr Gutman is officially confirmed new Ambassador to Belgium.
